In the long term, e-Borders will help to enhance the passenger journey by expediting the process for legitimate travellers.

This intelligence-led approach will help to improve the security, effectiveness and efficiency of the UK's border operations by harnessing the latest technology that will allow for the swift and secure transfer of advance passenger data whilst delivering faster processing and greater flexibility in border control operations.
